4. <u>Day of reflection on local governance</u>

The GM summarized how the day was going to go and indicated that good participation is expected. The only disappointment was that no senior officials from the Department of the Environment and Local Governments were going to attend. They were sent a reminder about the day of reflection a few days earlier.

5. Regional airport

The Chair mentioned a discussion with Mr. Luc Michaud of Aéroport Madawaska Airport (AMA) on the possibility of developing an agreement to transfer the Saint-Léonard airport to NWRSC. The answer was "no".

According to AMA, it would cost \$75,000 a year to keep the Saint-Léonard airport operational.

Mr. Pierre Michaud asked if it would be possible to share their information (game plan) for the development of both airports and a breakdown of the \$75,000 costs for discussion with NWRSC's Board of Directors.

Mr. Luc Michaud said that he would discuss it with his Board and get back to us with a reply soon.

6. Other business

The GM said that there would be meetings shortly with clients of Solid Waste Services to renegotiate payment agreements and schedule the installments.
