8. Income Statement to end of October 2018, for approval

Motion No. 5

Upon motion duly made by Mr. Marcel Deschênes, seconded by Mr. Roger Levesque and unanimously carried, it was

RESOLVED TO accept the income statement as of October 31, 2018, as circulated, with a budget deficit of \$ 92,992.67, which represents almost the entire loss of the Biogas segment due to the breakage of the generator, therefore loss income and repair costs.

Motion No. 6

Upon motion duly made by Mr. Cyrille Simard, seconded by Mrs. Mme Nicole Somers and unanimously carried, it was

RESOLVED That for the planning sector, that

- The NWRSC authorizes the reimbursement of a building permit whose project has been canceled. The building permit bore # 14184 in the name of Lyse Coulombe de Saint-Quentin, the receipt is # 6998 and Mrs. Coulombe paid her building permit in the amount of \$ 665 on September 12, 2018 by check # 92.
 - We reimbursed her permit on October 9, 2018 with check # 7798 for \$ 665. The latter will not be given to the city of Saint-Quentin during the quarterly repayment from July to September 2018.
- The NWRSC authorizes a stop payment on check # 7798 in the amount of \$ 665 made to Ms. Lyse Coulombe, mentioned above, because it had not been sent to the correct address. It was replaced by check # 7916 on October 25, 2018 at the same amount, \$ 665. This stop payment was approved by 2 signing officers on Accès D, Messrs. Jean-Pierre Ouellet and France Roussel via Internet via Accès-D of the Caisse populaire.
- That the NWRSC authorize a transfer of funds for the reimbursement of permits to municipalities and LSD for the months of July to September 2018. The amount of transfer of funds is \$ 18,800.15 from account 29434 ES-2 to current account NWRSC, folio 29434. The difference between the total repayments of \$ 44,538.15 and the transfer of funds from the bank account of \$ 18,800.15 is due to the fact that several payments are received by credit card and / or debit that are deposited directly into the NWRSC's current account. This transfer was approved on November 2, 2018 by two signing officers, Messrs. Jean-Pierre Ouellet and France Roussel via the Accès-D Internet of the Caisse populaire.

RESOLVED That for the solid waste sector, the NWRSC authorize a capital loan request by the municipalities of \$ 1.2 million for a period of 10 years for the building that will be used for the recycling program.

RESOLVED That for the solid waste sector, NWRSC authorize an application for a capital loan of \$ 230,000 for a period of 5 years for the purchase of a loader and 2 trailers and \$ 900,000 for a period of 5 years for the recycling bins that will be reimbursed by the concerned municipalities thereafter. Municipalities will have the choice to refund them upon delivery or to finance them over a maximum period of 5 years.

Mrs. Somers withdraws from discussions declaring conflict of interest

As a result of Mrs. Somers' letter, members can not grant a one-year reprieve allowing the Town of Saint-Quentin to withdraw from the NWRSC land use services as of December 31, 2019 and to advise the Town of Saint Quentin that NWRSC must follow the Regional Service Delivery Act which states that a municipality must give notice to the NWRSC at least two years before withdrawing from the services.

b) Budget 2019 Budget for the Core Leadership Team of Acadia of the Lands and Forests, for approval

Following a discussion, it was noted that funding for the Core Leadership Team of Acadian of the Lands and Forests is a regional collaboration project and is on a voluntary basis at a contribution of \$ 1 per person. Note that the following members do not participate in the service: Town of Grand Falls, Village of Drummond, Town of Saint-Leonard and the Village of Sainte-Anne de Madawaska.
